General Data Protection Rules (GDPR)

From 25th May 2018 the law regarding data protection is changing. We are therefore contacting you to let you know how the Bleu du Maine Sheep Society is managing and storing your data.

The Bleu du Maine Society is a membership organisation and as a member you have given us your details through a subscription or renewal, you therefore do not need to do anything; however, if you wish to 'opt out' and not receive information from the Bleu du Maine Sheep Society, please see the information below, on how to do so.

Grassroots. When you next log on and before you can go to Manage My Flock you will need to tick the box on the left hand side of the screen so that we know you are up to date with GDPR. This message will only appear once, and will register on our system the date you agreed. If at any time you wish us to change your details please let us know.

Communications from The Bleu du Maine Sheep Society are usually via email or post, but communication preferences can be changed as and when requested by the individual.

We will use the information you have given us for informing you of Society events, managing your membership and registrations/transfers and general flock management of the sheep we have registered with you.

By accepting these terms you permit us to use photographs to promote the breed either on the web site or in social media.

The Bleu du Maine Sheep Society will always hold all personal data securely and we do not share your data with any other organisations.

You are always in control of the information we hold. If you wish for any changes to your data and how we use it, please contact me directly.

The Grassroots system is a great way of managing your flock, you can delete sheep you have culled or died, register your lambs, highlight sheep you have for sale so that they appear in the Stock for Sale search and you don't have to find a pen! All can be done on the keyboard. If you are interested in pedigrees you can go back many generations to gain information, so it is a great resource tool. If you find you are having a few

problems or are not sure about something please just give me a ring.
